What We're Looking For

We publish articles that:

- Cover environmental issues, research, policy, and practice
- Are grounded in credible evidence
- Help readers understand *why* an issue matters, not just *what* is happening

Topics could include (but are not limited to) climate science, biodiversity and conservation, environmental policy, energy transitions, green finance, environmental justice, urban sustainability.

Article Length and Structure

Typical articles range between **700 and 1,000 words**, unless otherwise discussed.

We encourage:

- Short paragraphs for readability
- A concise introduction that sets context
- A strong conclusion that summarises key takeaways

Evidence & Sources

Our writers are expected to:

- Use reliable, verifiable sources (e.g. peer-reviewed research, official statistics, reputable institutions)

- Clearly reference data, studies, and direct quotations
- Be transparent about uncertainty or limitations in the evidence

Where possible, **include hyperlinks to original sources**, especially for research or data references.

Tone & Style

- **Objective and balanced:** Articles should aim to be informative rather than persuasive. Where debates exist, acknowledge multiple perspectives fairly.
- **Clear and readable:** Write for an informed general audience. Avoid excessive academic jargon but explain technical terms where needed.

Editing and Feedback

All accepted articles are subject to editorial review. We work collaboratively with writers and will never make changes without consultation.

How to Submit

- A short author bio (2-3 sentences)
- Relevant experience, qualifications, expertise
- Links to examples of previous writing (only if available)
